JIM'S SWIM TEAM Where did the idea come from?

We bought double down tickets for that first World Finals show and we have ever since. We had such a blast that we got double down tickets for 2008 as soon as they went on sale. [...] Of course it was so much fun we knew we would get tickets for the next year.

While flying home from the 2008 World Finals we started making plans for the next year. So there we are on the plane talking about banners people make and the kids you see in Grave Digger driver suits. We knew we didn't want to do the same old thing, that just isn't us. The conversation shifted to picking a driver that everyone likes, and build a theme around that. Well, of course the first one we thought of was Jim "Mr. Excitement" Koehler. Everyone can agree on cheering for Jim and Avenger, he has that contagious energy. [...] Well, what is something Jim is now famous for at the World Finals? Jumping in the water!

So that's how we came to form "Jim's Swim Team." In 2009 it was just our family; Brian, Rachel, Isabella, and Noah. [...] This year, 2010, it grew to include some friends; Nick, Nicole, Zack, and Derek. At the Pit Party this year we gave Jim his own T Shirt, which

he wore while taking his swim after a great Freestyle run this year.





Even though you're now driving the Wrecking Crew, you are still wrenching on the trucks and doing all the painting and a lot of body work at the shop. Describe what needs to be done in a typical week of work.

The first thing to do when we come back from a show is to unload the trucks out of the trailer and wash them. Aftewards, we have to change the motor oil and check the filter. Next is to assess the damages of the weekend and figure out a plan of attack on fixing them. Once this is done, I will unbolt any broken parts and let Jim know what we need to fix it.

If there was a rollover that weekend, the body needs to be unbolted. The spots that were damaged need to be cleaned and ground. Then, more fiberglass is added to repair the damages.

Depending on how bad it was, sometimes bondo and paint work need to be done.

On April 17, in Montreal, you drove Brutus. Are you going to drive it regularly this summer?

I drove Brutus couple of times this year so far, filling in for Chris. After having a rough beginning of the year (our fabrication shop burned down, and his dad passed away), he decided that he would spend more time with his family, so I will be driving Brutus for him this summer at some shows.

I would rather be driving the Wrecking Crew, but if Chris or Jim ever need me to fill in, I'm there.
